We are indeed blessed to place this Annual Report for the Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organization, Maharashtra & Goa for the year 2016-17 at the Divine Lotus Feet of our Beloved Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba.

Some of the highlights are

• Educational Wing: To spread the value-based education to children at large, the Balvikas team of Maharashtra & Goa have adopted a large number of schools for conducting Balvikas classes. The support received from the school authorities is overwhelming.

By Bhagwan's grace Balvikas Wing of Maharashtra & Goa took up a pilot project of involving schools where Balvikas classes are being conducted, in value-based competitions. This project was done by Mumbai District and was named as 'Sai Tarang'. The finale of the programme was held in Dharmakshetra and all the school principals participated in the programme and received Bhagwan's blessings.

• **Spiritual Wing:** Spiritual fervor has been gaining momentum year after year with regular holding of Sadhana Camps, Study Circles, mass chanting of Rudram, performing Rudrabhishekams, organizing Samarpan talks by Swami's devotees who were blessed with DIVINE association.

Keeping the spirit of the Sarva Dharma Samabhav teachings of our beloved Swami, multi faith events continued to be organized in the various districts through the year.

• Service Wing: Service activities continue unabated with the medical activities including static medical camps, mobile medical vans, outdoor clinics reaching out to lakhs of poor & underprivileged people, many of who are from remote villages, at their doorsteps.. Rain Water Harvesting Methods have been deployed in about 25 drought-hit/prone villages giving very encouraging results. Special emphasis has been given to projects concerning upliftment of children in tribal schools and for mitigating malnutrition in children across Maharashtra. Bhagawan is the only source of our inspiration and guide to enable us to perform the Seva.

However, the contribution of our Seva Dal, volunteers and devotees are also immensely important to us to spread the love of Bhagawan far and wide.

The photos with the write-ups in the following pages bring forth the spectrum of the activities conducted during the year, with fervor and utmost devotion. Truly, pictures speak for themselves presented by all the 31 Districts of Maharashtra & Goa .

We offer our sincere prayers to Bhagawan that may He make us His worthy instruments to transform our lives spiritually.

CSR PROJECT

Thane Samithi adopted a village called Talwade in the year 2008 which is situated 92 kms from Thane at the foothills of sahyadri range. This village consist of tribal settlement of approximately 250 families. The village backed the basic amenities like Water, toilets, medical facilities, Water for irrigation etc., Most of the people are farmers who are highly dependent on rains for cultivation. To reach the nearest public health centre one has to travel 7 kms.

The village had only kutcha houses, source of water dry most time of the year & Zilla Parishad school in dilapidated condition.

SSSSO Thane spread the love in the village and started conducting Medical Camps regularly in the village. Poor & weak were taken care. Regular eye camps were conducted and corrective actions were taken wherever necessary. The Basic problems of the village are

- 1)Lack of Water in the village
- 2) Lack of good education at the village due to poor infrastructure.

If the above two were taken care, then the village will be in a position to fight the poverty. This would ensure long term sustainability of the village.

Having identified the problems, SSSSO Thane identified the spring at the old bund in the village and decided to repair the bund to hold water throughput the year.

By Bhaghwan's grace a leading MNC helped under CSR activity with which a solar pump set was installed and a pipeline from bund to village (approximate distance 2 kms) was laid with the assistance of local population in the form of service. With this, the water is made available throughout the year and the same is also used for irrigation.

Having resolved the first major problem, the SSSSO Thane concentrated in the second issue by repairing the school and made the same the best in that region. The unemployed youth in the village were trained to have better future.

Not only the above, by Bhaghwan's abundance grace a new school for the entire panchayat was constructed and the new lease of life is made available to Talwada village.

All the above could be achieved with the grace of Bhaghwan, the help of leading MNC through Corporate Social Responsibility Scheme and above all the cooperation of the local people and lastly the love extended by the Brothers and Sisters of SSSSO Thane.





MOBILE MEDICARE





PREAMBLE

1)Quality healthcare is the privilege of only a small percentage of the population. Only 60% of India lives in villages and over 20% of the remaining lives in chawls and slums. Most of them are struggling for their daily sustenance, leave alone having surplus for even basic healthcare.

2)According to a WHO team -which stated after it had surveyed India's healthcare -that if Indians are to enjoy better health, utmost importance should be given to primary and preventive healthcare.

PREAMBLE

3)The project keeps in mind Bhagawan's words that efforts to serve must spring from a concern for the suffering of others and the service must be a genuine effort to get rid of that anguish. Bhagawan has told his devotees:-"Do not wait for the opportunity to serve, go out and grab the opportunity which is already available".

4)Hospitals & Clinics play a useful role but a vast number of diseases can be nipped in the bud by providing timely treatment and thus avoiding complicated treatment at a later stage. The Mobile Dispensary is the "MOST VIABLE ALTERNATIVE" in terms of cost, time and manpower resources.



RAIN WATER HARVESTING

Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisation Maharashtra and Goa has been doing Rainwater harvesting since last five years.

After extensive study and meeting the experts in this field across the country, a few low cost models were evolved like recharging the abandoned bore wells with Rainwater, reviving dead wells, deepening Village ponds and lakes etc, small check dams, earthen dams etc

This year we have done in 5 villages as follows:

- 1. Kolura II tal Digras Yavatmal
- 2. Lakhrayaji Tal Digras Yavatmal
- 3. Gorakshan Yavatmal dist
- 4. Alkud II Tk Kavthe mahankal Sangli dist
- 5. Sankh Tk Jath So far we have done Rainwater harvesting in 55 villages including certain villages in two phases.





VOCATIONAL TRAINING

Though we wanted to start our own Vocational training centre in Maharashtra, as a prelude to that we wanted to mobilise the rural youth and get them trained in already established training centres run by other institutions with huge vacancies and after testing water we wanted to start our own later.

So far the learning has been good. We mobilised more than 500 rural youth mostly drop outs above 18 years old with min education of 8th Std. and got them trained in



established vocational training institutes in different locations in Maharashtra with arrangement with them. So far 431 youth including a few girls have been trained in different trades like AC mechanic, Electricians, Welders etc., and few who completed graduation have been trained in Retail and Sales etc. Most of the youth trained have been gainfully employed. These candidates are mobilised by our Sai Samithis from local villages they serve.



ASHRAM SHALAS

Ashramshalas are govt. run boarding schools for Adivasi kids from 1st to 12th standard. They are both govt run and private NGO run Ashramshalas in Maharashtra. After talking to the Tribal welfare department we took up the following Govt run Ashramshalas with very poor facility for the kids staying there based on an initial survey. We provide monthly medical check-up with medicines and other basic inputs urgently needed including water storage, kitchen vessels, bedding, toilet repair, ceiling fans and lights, painting, rainwater harvesting besides notebooks , drawing kits , sports goods, boxes and Projector with animated lessons as per syllabus for Digital class room etc and also conduct moral lessons during the medical check-up.

We have taken up 8 such Ashramshalas mostly in Shahpur dist. and intend to take a few more to service.

REPORT ON MOTHER & CHILD FOR THE YEAR 2016-2017

By the Divine Grace, the SRI SATHYA SAI MOTHER AND CHILD CARE PROJECT is gaining great momentum in the year 2016-2017.

Since its inception in 2009, it is now, that the project is blooming.

Out of 31 districts in the state of Maharashtra and Goa, 22 districts are actively and successfully implementing this beautiful program.

Eventually, we have over 100 trained ladies and hundreds of beneficiaries. Regular Training sessions, follow up meetings and Implementation sessions at adopted villages adds to the proper functioning.

A very vibrant and motivational meet was conducted at GOA, in January 2017. The districts were asked to make presentations which was a unique initiative. Variety of folk types like Bharud, Powada, Role Plays, Gazals, Songs, Poetry, etc were the tools used which made the session interesting and interactive. Indeed a great learning experience.

It was an additional benefit to be able to meet and interact with great Social workers like Dr. Prakash Amte at Hemalkasa and Dr. Abhay Bang and Dr. mrs. Rani Bang at Gadchiroli. It definitely added inputs for the betterment of Mother and Child Care project.

With this saying of Swami as the goal for Balvikas, team Balvikas from twin states of Maharashtra and Goa embarked to reach out and bring in an awareness of the need for Value Education

School Balvikas started in a large scale throughout the twin states and currently we have 203 centers where 13345 children receive value education during school hours. These schools are from urban as well as rural areas



Balvikas Classes have also been started in schools adopted under Vidyajyoti programme.

As a pilot project value based competitions were held in the schools for the children in the District of Mumbai and the children and principals of the schools were brought to Dharmakshetra for the F.inals This year the project has been extended to all school Balvikas students in the entire States of Maharashtra & Goa.



To bring in an awareness about the need for Value Education, Summer and Winter camps are organized in all the districts for Non-Balvikas children. This results in increase in number of Balvikas centres and Balvikas Children.



To increase the number of Balvikas Gurus, parents of the existing Balvikas children are trained and involved in School Balvikas.

We shall continue our efforts of reaching out to as many children as possible through Residential Balvikas, School Balvikas as well as Vidya Jyoti programme. We also plan to include as many Parents and Balvikas Alumni as possible, so that our hands are strengthened and we are ready to spread our wings in the States of Maharashtra and Goa.

We pray to Swami to motivate and guide us in this endeavor.

On the occasion of Guru Purnima Day, Sai Samiti, Nanded had organized bhajans when 80-90 Sai devotees participated.





Medical College under the guidance of Sai Samiti, Nanded.







Along with our senior surgeons, many New eye specialists have joined the hospital, which helps cases of Squint, DCR, YagLazer, Pterygium, Chalazion, Cyst removal, Epilation, etc.

The Mobile Medicare Project was launched with the Blessings of Bhagawan in July 2008.

The mobile dispensaries are fully equipped with a range of medicines and equipments for diagnosis and treatment of patients. The medical vans are the most viable alternative in terms of cost, time and manpower resources, to reach out to distant and also remote areas.

FEATURES OF THE MOBILE MEDICARE PROJECT

- Acquisition of several mobile dispensaries fully equipped with necessary facilities available at a General Practitioner's Clinic.
- Envisage the provision of free medical treatment and medicines in a professional manner.
- Manned by professionals supported by our seva dal and volunteers.
- Visiting fixed centres, orphanages, destitute homes, old folks homes, etc., as per a fixed schedule.
- Bone Density, Eye and Dental, Mother and Child Care Camps etc., to be conducted at regular intervals.
- Provision of Pathological tests where necessary.
- Directing serious cases to affliated hospitals.
- Vaccination Camps jointly with government bodies.
- Coordinating with local groups for a proper health plan.
- Eradication of malnutrition a providing nutritional support on a massive scale particularly to children and women.
- Spreading the Value Oriented Teachings of Bhagawan at all centres through BalVikas, Study Circles, Bhajans etc.

- Arrangement of immunization for the pregnant mothers and children. Close monitoring of the chain of immunization among the children in different age.
- Popularization of locally available low cost but nourishing food items among the mothers and children through awareness generation.
- Ensuring the safe delivery of babies.
- Popularizing breast feeding among the mothers.
- Monitoring growth of children.
- Provision of supplementary nutrition (Sai Protein) to the mal-nourished children.
- Conducting health check-up for the children and giving them referral services for better treatment.
- Attending to common childhood illness to ensure child survival.

At present 132 villages are selected and the services of mobile medical van is extended to these villages.



B) MOTHER AND CHILD CARE:

The mother and child care programme was launched in the district in 2009. The Villages covered were Warora, Gondpimpari, Aarvat, Yenbodi etc. During the year 2016-17, time to time visits were organised and ladies were made aware of this programme. During the visit to each village the various aspects like care to be taken before and after delivery, care to be taken during pregnancy, importance of breast feeding, vaccination of mother and child, family planning, women and cancer, HIV/AIDS and women teenagers problems and care to be etc have been discussed with ladies of those villages and many ladies were benefitted.

Under mother & child care programme, various projects carried out in villages only for women & children. These projects comprises of various checkups, tests, guidance on health related issues.

VARIOUS TESTS TAKEN FOR GIRLS & WOMEN IN VILLAGES

Due to illiteracy, poverty and unawareness, the girls & women health issues are most critical in tribal areas and villages. The hospital or medical facilities are not available in such type of villages. Even doctors doesn't want to go for practice in tribal villages. As, they are illiterate as well as poor people, as they don't go for costly treatment or medicines.

So, considering all these problems, Chandrapur Samithi have decided to sevice these needy women & girls. The ladies sevadal alongwith the experienced ladies doctors visits such villages & give services free of cost. The doctors are also guide on critical diseases & various health related issues to them.

Under the mother & child care projects, various health programmes were successfully accomplished in the year (2016-17) such as,

1.GUIDENCE & CHECKUP CAMP

The checkup & guidance on various diseases like B.P., DIABETES, MEMOGRAPHY & PAP SMEARS at KAWATHI on 20/11/2016 & at ITOLI on 26/01/2016. The doctors available for these camp were, Dr.Rutuja Mundhada, Dr.Prerna Kolte, Dr.Sharmili Poddar, Dr.Jyoti Wasade, Dr.Sandhya More.

2.DENTAL CAMP FOR STUDENTS

The Dental camp arranged for the students at Ranirajkunwar Primary School, Chandrapur. The doctors were Dr. Jivane & Dr. Jyoti Dongarwar available for the camp.



3. SICKLE CELL GUIDENCE & CHECKUP CAMP

The guidance & checkup camp on sickle cell disease were arranged at school & college, named as,

- I. Bhaurao Karmaveer Mahavidyalaya, Yenbodi, Chandrapur
- II. Hinglaj Bhavani Highschool, Babupeth, Chandrapur.





C) NARAYANA SEVA



During the visit to each village the various aspects like care to be taken before and after delivery, care to be taken during pregnancy, importance of breast feeding, vaccination of mother and child, family planning, women and cancer, HIV/AIDS and women teenagers problems and care to be etc have been discussed with ladies of those villages and about 200 ladies were benefitted.



C) Sri Satya Sai Village Integrated Progrmme: The malnourished children were identified and Sai-Proteins packets were distributed to the pregnant ladies and malnourished children.



D) NARAYAN SEVA: The Narayan Seva is continuously undertaken in the district. Once in a month the meals are provided to Leporsy persons at Dattapur Ashram in Wardha District. About 150 persons are beneficiated .This is organized by Sri Satya Sai Seva organization Wardha Samiti. During every month, Narayan Seva is done in 100 villages selected in Mobile Medicare Project in Hinganghat and Samudrapur tahshils of the district. Other Samithis also participated in Narayan Seva.



E) SAWCH BHARAT ABHIYAN : The Swach Bharat Abhiyan is continuously undertaken in the district. 15 villages are participated this progragam 600 hours work was done.



F) Youth guidance camp: The Youth Guidence camp was held at Wardha in presence of State Youth President Mr. Dharmesh Vidya and Wardha Dist President Mr. P.M.Tadas about 120 Youth and devotees participated in this camp was held at Gramin Seva Kendra, Bhidi.



G) Free soil and water testing camp in Siadapur, Ganeshpur, Hamdapur and Bhidi: Excessive use of chemical fertilizers over the years has been causing damage to the soil and ground water resources in and around Bhidi.

With a view to sensitising the farmers to the importance of restoring the texture of the soil and consequent conservation of ground water table, the Shri Sathya Sai Seva Samiti, Bhidi and chemical & fertilizers LTD. has taken up a free soil and water testing camp at 4 select villages in the periphery of Bhidi town.

The camp has been conducted at Siadapur, Ganeshpur, Hamdapur and Bhidi villages, at the rate of 50 samples a village, the scientists attached to the chemical & fertilizers LTD Mobile Soil Testing laboratory, have collected 150 samples of soil and water from the farmers' fields and wells.

The camp aimed at enhancing productivity of paddy, chillies and sugarcane in the area, he added.



H) Sathya Sai Seva Samiti, Bhidi Conduts Veterinary camp at. Ganeshpur: Sathya Sai Seva Samiti, Bhidi, conducted a vaccination cum health check up camp in Ganeshpur village in Wardha district on August 9 in which a total of 120 mithuns were vaccinated against Foot and Mouth Diseases (FMD) besides administering health check-up.

Mineral supplements, deformers and first aid medicine were distributed during the programme.

FMD is a highly contagious disease of viral origin and known to inflict huge economic loss among the farmers of the State. However, regular immunization against the dreaded disease could give protection from constant risk of exposure to the virus. FMD vaccines were provided by the Department of Veterinary and Animal Husbandry, Government of Maharastra. Ear tags were applied to the calves and adult animals to keep proper records and identification. On constant motivation and demonstration by Samiti , the farmers of the village have taken to regular vaccination and other prophylactic care of their animals.

Mr. Vilas Narnavare farmers have expressed gratitude to the Director of Veterinary and Animal Husbandry and the Devotees of Swami on Ganeshpur, Saidapur in Wardha district for extending valuable service to the farmers and the village.

I) SAI GAYATRI YAGYA: Organized Sai Gayatri Yagaya Smt.Bhumika Aade House at.Wardha 150 devotee was participated this Yagaya.



J) PRASHANTI SEVA: About 90 gents and 65 ladies attend the Prashanti Seva during the month of March and September every year. There is good response from the Sevadal for Prashanti Seva from the District.





PALGHAR

Palghar is the 36th district of the State of Maharashtra. It was recently formed in the year 2014 and was carved out of the Thane District. Palghar district comprises of talukas of Palghar, Vada, Vikramgad, Jawhar, Mokhada, Dahanu, Talasari and Vasai-Virar. Palghar has a population of 29,90,116 out of which 48% live in urbanized area.

Sri Sathya Seva Organization of Palghar District was formed on December 18, 2016. Sri Sathya Seva Organization of Palghar District comprises of 4 Samithis which are Boisar, Khardi-Virar, Vasai and Mira Road. Though geographically speaking Mira Road belongs to the Thane District, but in our Organization it belongs to the Palghar District.

There are more than 500 ardent devotees residing in the district of Palghar. Throughout the year various seva activities are undertaken by the respective Samithis from Palghar district. Following are the Various service activities undertaken by the Sri Sathya Seva Organization Palghar District in the year 2016-2017. These core services can be broadly classified into:

EDUCATION WING

As Swami always used to say that Bal Vikas is not just an education for children. It is the essence of all spiritual knowledge. It is Educare for Loka Vikas. Thus regular Balvikas classes has been conducted at various Samithis of the Palghar District. Many children including both well to do and not so privileged are recipients of Sri Sathya Sai Balvikas Programme. The ultimate aim of Balvikas is to make the children realize that Divinity dwells in him. A typical Balvikas class would begin with Shloka Chanting, Stories from our Ancient Scriptures, Bhajans, Silent Sitting, various activates including Drawing, sketching, games etc.

WINTER CAMPS

Other than that various Winter Education camps were held at different Samithi. One of these camps were organized by the Virar Samithi. The camp was held from December 26th 2016 to January 01st 2017 at Y.K. Nagar Ganesh Mandir, Virar (W) from 5 pm to 7 pm. VISIT TO GLOBAL VIPASSANA PAGODA

Mira Road Samithi on January 29, 2017 arranged for a trip to the Global Vipassana Pagoda, Gorai- Bhayander for the Balvikas children. Standing at the height of 99 mtrs, the center of the Global Vipassana Pagoda contains the world's largest stone dome built without any supporting pillars. Inside the pagoda there are 108 meditation halls where Buddhist monks do rigorous meditation. Swami always used to quote in his Discourse the glory of Lord Buddha. He narrates it with a short story,

The old woman approached Buddha staggering on her legs, and offered to him the pomegranate fruit. Buddha took it and immediately sounded the little drum.

The Maharaja asked Buddha: "I offered so much wealth to you. You did not sound the drum. But you rattled it after receiving a small fruit. Is this a great sacrifice?"

Buddha replied: "Maharaja! In sacrifice, it is not quantity that counts, it is the quality of sacrifice that matters. But what great sacrifice is made when a hungry old woman offers the pomegranate fruit to the Guru despite her hunger. She did not care even for her life and gave the fruit. What greater sacrifice can there be? It is not sacrifice to offer what is superfluous for you. True sacrifice means giving up that which is most dear to you, that which you value most."

"Children do not come to you, but through you. Parents must feel that they are servants appointed by the Lord to tend little souls that are born in their households, as the gardener tends the trees in the garden of the Master."

RARA

Swami always emphasized on the importance of parents. He always holds the analogy that children are like wet clay and parents are the potter. They have the greatest responsibility in moulding out the future for their children. With this view Swami started the Parenting Programme. All the Samithis in the Palghar District have taken initiative in holding Parenting sessions in their respective Samithis.

Parenting workshop and Balvikas Guru's training were regularly held and conducted at Various Samithi. Other than that Experiential learning for students of 5th to 8th standard in Homi Bhabha School, TAPS colony was conducted by the Boisar Samithi. Separate topics were given to each class and models were displayed during their Annual Day Programme.



SERVICE WING

If you lift the hand to serve, to help, to console, to encourage another man, you are lifting it for God, for God is in every man.

As Swami always used to emphasize the fact that the hands that serve are holier than the lips that pray. Health is the biggest wealth a man can possess. A healthy nation is a wealthy nation. But what we see is a contrasting picture. Majority of our healthcare is unable to percolate inside the rural India. All the so called health care institutions have rooted themselves in the cities. What we see then is the poor people treading all the way from their villages to the nearby government hospitals. These overcrowded hospitals don't have the proper amenities to accommodate such a large number of people. At the end it is the most pitiable sight that we watch of the patients and relatives lying outside the hospitals on pavements, verandahs, stairs unattended. Private Hospitals seems to be the panacea for these poor. But these patients are deprived of these services due to the exorbitant bills. So where do they go? A poor villager is stranded with no choice.

SRI SATHYA SAI MEDICAL VAN PROJECT

Here comes the vision which Swami envisaged. If people cannot go to the hospitals, then the hospital should come to the people. That's where the idea of Sri Sathya Sai Mobile Medical Van was sown. It is the classic example of Hospital-on-wheels.

All the Samithis of the Palghar District viz Mira Road, Boisar, Khardi-Virar, Vasai have been reaching out to the poor through the Mobile Medical Van. A medical van is equipped with all types of common medicines which a normal person requires on a day to day basis. Not only the van is accompanied by a trained doctor but also a trained seva dal who render their service by assisting the doctor with the medicines. Each village is regularly visited on a weekly /fort nightly/monthly basis. A Samithi typically adopts 4 to 5 villages where these camps have been conducted recurrently. Records of the Patients are properly filled by the Seva dals which are filed and is for further study.



Here we see Vasai Samithi Conducting their mobile medical care at Interior Villages of Vasai like Dongri Pada, Koliwada. All patients are treated free of Cost. Here on the left seated is the doctor who is being helped by the Seva Dals for distributing the Medicine.

Mira road Samithi has also taken an active lead in the Mobile Medicare Project. Serving more than 1000 people on a monthly basis. Mobile Van goes through seven villages where the Seva is being conducted on weekly regular basis.



Mira Road Medical Van Project. Here we see both the Registration side and Patient Side working in full swing. Mira road conducts its Medical Seva in the villages on the outskirts of the city i.e. are Chena, Dajkulpada, Maschichapada, Gagangiri, Kajupada, Modern Company and Versova village.

Here in Boisar Samithi Medical Seva is conducted on monthly basis. Villages who are recipients of the Medi Care project are Panshet pada, Makarchola, Chinchani, New Dandi pada. All these villages are located in Boisar (East). On an average 45-55 patients were benefited in each camp.

Again we have the Khardi Virar Samithi who regularly conduct Medical Seva in their adopted Villages and other Economically backward area and vridhashram on every Sunday and Monday. A total Number of 300 needy people are being served by these Mobile Medical project. Khardi Virar even took the initiative of helping out the old deprived people who are suffering from Cataract. These old people were taken to Dharmakshetra which is our Bhagavan's abode in Maharashtra for free Cataract Surgery. Approximately 63 patients underwent through the cataract surgery which was done for free of cost.



Virar- Khardi Samithi has also been part of other service projects. Every year the academic season would begin by the month of June. During this time, itself free distribution of notebooks to the Zila Parishad Schools in Khardi Virar is done. Many poor students who couldn't afford the necessary and basic stationery were beneficiary to this Programme.

On 31st December 2016 when most of the city is on festive mood because of the dawn of new year. There are those penurious people who lie under the roof of Chilly moon. To give them the warmth of support and succor, blankets were distributed by the devotees of the Khardi- Virar Samithi to these poor people. 28 needy Narayana's were recipients of the blankets on New year's eve.

SWACHATA SE DIVYVATA TAK

You cannot be fresh and feeling fine, wearing a washed vest under an unwashed shirt; or, an unwashed vest over a washed shirt. Both have to be clean, to provide a sense of tingling joy. So too outer and inner cleanliness is but the reflection of the inner achievement.

As Swami always used to say that Cleanliness is next to Godliness which literally translates to "Swachata se Divyavata tak". Coinciding with the message from our PM on Swach Bharat. All the Samithis of the Palghar district engaged in the Programme of cleaning their neighborhood surrounding. More emphasis was done on making people aware of the importance of Cleanliness on day to day basis.



KHARDI VIRAR SAMITHI

Khardi – Virar had Conducted Swachata Abhiyan at Khardi Village on 16th October-2016 and tried to clean all Khardi and surrounding area during the day with the team of 25 Mahila Sevadals, 27 Gents Sevadals, 20 Balvikas Students children. As a part of it we can visibly see a neater neighborhood and a beautiful bus stop.



MIRA ROAD SAMITHI

The Sri Sathya Seva Samithi, Mira road undertook a cleanliness drive by cleaning the entire streets of Poonam Sagar (Mira Road) on October 20, 2016. As part of the Programme 20 dust bins were distributed to all the families. Other than that, many of the residents were taught the importance of maintaining a clean neighborhood and environment. The cleanliness drive was attended by 2 Balvikas kids, 14 Mahila sevadals and 3 gents sevadals.

SWACHATA SE DIVYAVATA TAK BY VASAI SAMITHI

"Swachata se divyada tak" has been conducted by Sri Sathya Sai Seva Samithi, Vasai at Dongri Pada, Ever shine City, Vasai (E), on 6th Nov-2016. Awareness about cleanliness was also taught to many of the residents in the nearby areas.

SPIRITUAL ACTIVITIES

Various spiritual activities were carried out across all samithis during the period. In addition to Regular bhajans that were conducted in each samithi, special bhajans were also conducted on occasions such as Ashadi Ekadashi, GuruPournima, Swami's Birthday. Shivaratri, Global Akhand Bhajan, Swami AraadhanaUtsav etc.

In Kalyan Samithi, chanting of 'Vishnu Sahasranamam' 'LalitaSahasranamam' 'Hanuman Chalisa' was carried out on different days. Special bhajans were also conducted on 4th Saturday of every month at the Thane Mental Hospital by Thane Samithi. Dombivili samithi carried out a ShobhaYatra rally on GudiPadwa day. The members of Ambernath Samithi participated in 1008 times chanting of Gayatri mantra on 20th November 2016.

Other spiritual activities carried out include:Self RealisationSadhana Activity and Spiritual Sadhana Camp at Sri Sathya Sai PandurangKshetra, Hadshi(Dombivilisamithi); one day 'Spiritual Retreat' on 28.05.2016 also at Hudshee (Kalyan Samithi). Regular rudram classes were conducted for devotees in most of the samithis.

SERVICE ACTIVITIES

A.Projects in village/slums

- •Sri Sathya Sai chariable trust, Ulhasnagar provided water to the needy in the slum areas of Ulhasnagar for 3 months (April-July). On an average daily 4 water tankers with approximately 130000 LTRS of water was provided.
- Thane Samithi carried out a water project (using solar powered pump) wherein pipelines was laid for 2kms from a concrete water reservoir (Bund) constructed by Thane Samithi to the adopted villages.



- Kalyan Samithi facilitated distribution of footwear to most needy school children and Senior Citizens in the Villages around Jambilghar Centre, Badlapur.
- •On January 1st 2017, Dombivili Samithi devotees distributed clothes, blankets &sarees to Adivasi people of Borale Village and around Shahapur.

B.Narayan seva

- Ambernath Samithi: On the 1st Sunday of every month Narayan Seva was conducted in Mirchiwadi (Adopted Village). National Narayan sevawas conducted at Shiv Mandir. Also, during Shivratrimela, a pandal was kept for distribution of water bottles and boiled groundnuts to all devotees.
- Dombivili Samithi: Maha Narayan Seva was conducted in Indira Nagar Slums on Aradhana Day (April 24th, 2016) and November 20th 2016.
- Kalyan Samithi: Narayan seva was conducted on major occasions like Aaradhana day and Global Akhanda bhajan.
- •Thane Samithi: Narayan seva was conducted on 1st Sunday of every month and by the Ladies wing on 19th of every month. Special Narayana Seva conducted by Balvikas students in the month of April by serving contract workers. Meeting patients and distribution of biscuit packets to them was carried outduring Civil Hospital Visits on 1st and 2nd Saturday of every month.
- •Ulhasnagar Samithi: Narayan seva was conducted every Sunday by distributing breakfast outside Sathya Sai Health Centre Ulhasnagar. Further on Friday few devotees went to villages, orphanages and slum areas for distributing food and other necessary items. National Narayan seva was conducted during Bhagwan's birthday and AaradhanaDay in 3-4 places in Ulhasnagar.



C.Medical/blood donation/awareness camps/clinics:

- Ambernath Samithi: 4 medical camps were conducted in Mirchiwadi
- Dombivili Samithi: New Allopathic Medical Camp started at Apti Village, Murbad on May 15th 2016 (95 beneficiaries) and Anna Nagar, Kopargaon on Jan 1st 2017 (90 beneficiaries). On December 5th to 7th 2016, cataract operations of 17 Adivasi persons from Murbad were conducted at Bachhually Eye Hospital, Parel. On December 11th 2016, blood donation camp was organized at Plasma Blood Bank, Dombivli wherein 16 Bottles of blood was donated. On October 22nd, Cancer & Diabetes Educative session held by a doctor couple.
- Kalyan Samithi: Medical Camp was organised by Kalyan Samithi on 3 occassions and Seva Dal volunteers also participated in the 'Eye Camp' held at Jambilghar Centre.
- •Thane Samithi: Sai Mega Medical Camp conducted in Gandulwadi/Talwade villages wherein 18 doctors participated and rendered their service. Dental/Eye/General conditions were addressed. More than 1200 patients including school children were administered medicine and were provided medical aid. Follow up Eye surgeries/Spectacles were also successfully completed at a hospital in Thane. Regular treatment and follow ups of identified malnourished children also done by the devotees and medical team.
- •Ulhasnagar samithi: Daily medical clinic (morning & evening, except Sundays) conducted at Sathya Sai Health Centre Ulhasnagar, wherein many doctors are rendering services, benefitting around 100 to 150. Physiotherapy facility is also provided. Daily medical van seva is also done by one of the devotee doctor in different areas of Ulhasnagar



D.Other service activities

• Swacchta Abhyan was carried out by the samithis (Kalyan, Ambernath, Dombivili) in their respective areas



- All samithis regularly participated in the bi annual Prasanthiseva
- Teaching Bhajans and values at Aanganwadi School located at Badlapurwas conducted on all Sundays by Kalyan Samithi
- A programe on rain water harvesting (RWH) was conducted by Ulhasnagar samithi wherein a semi model of RWH was used to educate about 13 corporators of political parties & around 250 people about benefits of RWH.

EDUCATION:

•Thane Samithi: A new school buil0ding with all facilities was constructed with the help of CSR funds to serve Ashramshalaschool at Gandulwadi, Talwadewhich was subsequently handed over to the school authorities. More than 450 children were the beneficiaries of the new school premises. Sathya Sai Vidyajyotiwas introduced in Adharsh English School, Thane.



- •Ambernath Samithi: Eswaramma day was celebrated on 6th May, 2016 wherein imparting of moral values through fun games was carried out. Balvikas rally with decorated rath was organized on 17th July 2016 with bhajansbeing led by the balvikas children.
- •Bhiwandi Samithi: Balvikas students actively participated in a small trip to Varaladevitalav and participated in various group games.



• Dombivili Samithi: Eswaramma Day was celebrated and also a cultural program was organised by Bal Vikas Children in Thakur Hall on November 27th, 2016.

A total of 102 balvikas centers exist across all samithis under Thane District, managed by 78 dedicated gurus. Total number of children in the balvikas programme including schools, rural, urban and slum areas was 2390.

Parenting workshop and Matru PitruPooja were conducted by all samithis, benefitting parents and children.

GOA

Education

1. Induction program by Dr Pitre

On 28/5/2016 an induction program was held for office bearers from Goa by Dr Pitre Around 25 office bearers attended this program. Itwas made very lively and lot of information about the organisation and its working was given to the participant's .Our State President Shri Ramesh Sawant also attended the session for some time.



2. Vidya Jyoti program in Goa

A total of 5 schools in different parts of Goa have been adopted under vidya jyoti program In all schools activities like, cleanliness, repairs, Veda training, parenting, etc are being undertaken. One school particularly at Neura the structure was in bad shape, urgent repairs and overall cleaning of premises was done by our vidya jyoti team



3. Balvikas activities

A)regular annual summer camps are held for balvikas children where in children.are given value based education, veda chanting ,value based games ,parenting and matru pitru poojan. These camps are well attended not only by balvikas students but other children also



B)Similary picnics for balvikas children are arranged every year wherein they are taken to picturesque places and they really have a great time.



C) On 20/11/2016 balvikas musical program was arranged at Panjim. Wherein they exhibited their talents in various fields .The program was well attended by parents and other devotees.



D) Other programs like parenting, training for gurus new and old are held on regular basis (Parenting Program photos below)



Spiritual

1.Bhajans

In all the 8 samities in Goa, regular weekly bhajans are held .Also special bhajans on festivals, at public places ,old age homes ,orphanages etc are also held on regular basis in different samities. A special mention must be made of curchorem/savordem samiti where daily Nagarsankirtan is being held for last 22 years. Sadhana camps, spiritual retreats, spiritual quiz programs are also organised periodically.



2. State level meet of Goa and Ratnagiri
